

## THE SURREY TEACHING CENTRE

The Surrey Teaching Centre is a Surrey maintained Medical Pupil Referral Unit based on the site of The Children's Trust. We have capacity to teach 24 pupils aged 2-19 years old.

We provide education on behalf of Surrey for all of the children and young people who come to The Children's Trust for rehabilitation placements. We work as part of the multi disciplinary team in the New Cheyne Centre.

## SMSC THEME

This term the school's topic is 'Change'. In Autumn 1 we will focus on social change and in Autumn 2 we will focus on Technological change.



## HOW WE FIT IN TO YOUR CHILD'S REHABILITATION PROGRAMME:

Each child or young person has an individual timetable including school sessions during the morning and afternoon session. Therapists may join in school lessons to support the pupil's access to education. Teachers aim to assess your child's abilities and work on areas that need some extra help. Teachers will write reports during your child's stay with us and are always available to talk with you and keep you updated on progress. Our final reports will help schools support your child when their rehab programme ends.
