Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance at Surrey Teaching Centre

Surrey Teaching Centre seeks to maximise the life chances of all our young people; we are committed to preparing young people for life beyond school. We aim to develop the knowledge, skills and attributes students need to lead successful lives and meet their full potential. The Management Committee have therefore adopted this statement to provide a clear commitment to and framework for Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance. Careers Education at Surrey Teaching Centre is delivered through the school's personal pathways curriculum. Through this pathway we seek to find opportunities to identify pupils' aspirations for the future following their acquired brain injury. It is not always possible or appropriate for pupils to be thinking about careers so early on in their recovery, however for some pupils on a stepdown placement, it has been possible to arrange work experience within the Trust.

Surrey Teaching Centre's Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance statement defines our commitment to the Department for Education's statutory expectations for careers guidance in schools. Our programme of activities is bespoke for each student and supports them in their transition back to their home schools or ongoing placements so that they are ready to choose a careers/preparation for adulthood pathway that suit their interests and skills.
