All children and young people admitted to The Children's Trust for neuro-rehabilitation between the ages of 2 and 17 are offered education from The Surrey Teaching Centre.

During term time, children and young people will have specialist teaching sessions as part of their rehabilitation timetable.

School sessions are fun, personalised and collaborative. Our staff will assess strengths and needs and develop an engaging personalised curriculum for each learner.

Post 16 learners (e.g. from the end of Yr 11) are above the age of compulsory education. An educational offer is still available to Post 16 learners if they choose to participate, with a focus on preparation for adulthood.
